Nicholas Buc is a composer, conductor, arranger, violinist and pianist. As the recipient of the Brian May Scholarship for Australian film composers, he recently completed a Master's degree in Scoring for Film and Multimedia at New York University, receiving the Elmer Bernstein Award for Film Scoring. Continuing his passion for music and film, he has conducted Disney's *Pixar In Concert*, *Star Trek, E.T., Harry Potter and Philosopher's Stone, Raiders of the Lost Ark, Psycho, Back To The Future* and *Star Trek: The Ultimate Voyage*. He has made appearances with all of the major Australian symphony orchestras as well as the Hong Kong, Malaysian, Tokyo and Osaka Philharmonic orchestras.
