

TRANSFORMING SOUTHBANK BOULEVARD AND DODDS STREET

CONSTRUCTION BULLETIN 9

March 2019

Construction continues on Southbank Boulevard, Sturt Street and Dodds Street. The majority of service works are now complete, and pavement and finishing works are commencing.

Detours will be in place around the work site, please be aware of changing conditions for pedestrians and vehicles as construction takes place in the area.

Current works

St Kilda Rd to Sturt Street

Construction work continues on this section of Southbank Boulevard, with bluestone paving works commencing, and roadway asphaltting to follow.

Further works will be undertaken to the Sturt St/Southbank Boulevard intersection towards the end of April, with the aim of having all civil works between St Kilda Rd and Sturt Street complete at the beginning of May, and construction activity moved to the west of Sturt Street in mid-May.

Sturt Street to City Road

As Southbank Boulevard reopens between St Kilda Rd and Sturt Street, construction will move west. The next stage of the project will require staged closures to enable utility, civil and traffic works. This period of construction between Sturt Street and City Road will commence in May and continue through until November 2019. The City Road intersection works will be undertaken in January 2020.

Landscape works

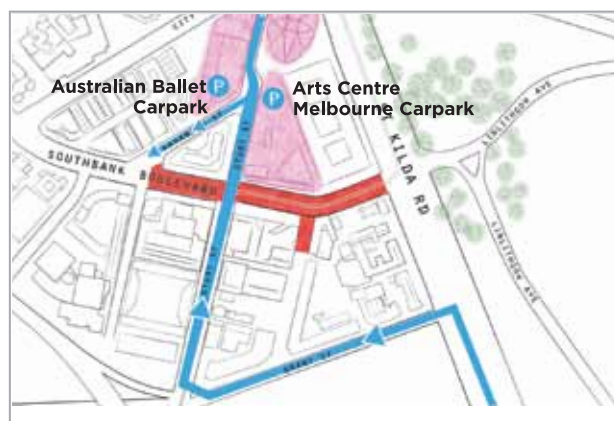
It's estimated that the delivery of the first public space projects will commence in mid-2019. The delivery of each of the landscape areas will continue through until mid-2020.

Construction of each of the open spaces will be much more localised, and the works will be contained within a defined site.

Once the civil works are complete we anticipate less of an impact on traffic in the surrounding area.

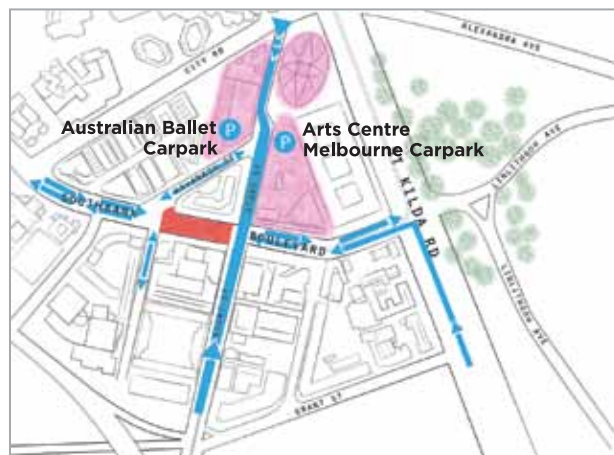
Local businesses in the area remain open during works.
