## Professional Learning Activities

### Mini lesson plan

**Title**

Find My Voice

**Year level suggested**

Years F-6

**Useful for**

Brain breaks

Listening

Concentration

Rhythm and pitch

**Materials**

A clear space in the classroom

**Background**

Kodaly music literacy game

**Lyrics (examples)**

Leader: 'This is my robot voice'

Class: 'This is my robot voice'

Leader: 'This is my monster voice'

Class: 'This is my monster voice'

Leader: 'This is my mousie voice'

Class: 'This is my mousie voice'

etc

**Learning intention**

To engage and refocus students through singing and to teach pitch

**Steps**

1. Think of a silly voice to use eg: dinosaur voice
2. Say in this silly voice 'This is my \_\_\_\_\_ voice'
3. The children copy in reply 'This is my \_\_\_\_\_ voice'
4. A new leader is chosen and the game continues with children thinking of different voices to use
5. To introduce another singing game, use a sing-song voice to the tune of *Starlight, Star bright*.

**Teacher [sung to Starlight]: 'This is my singing voice'**

**Class [sung]: 'This is my singing voice'**

**OR for fun...**

**Teacher: 'This is my listening voice'**

**Class: 'Silence'**

See who gets the joke!
